WHY PERFORMANCE, SAFETY, AND CONSISTENCY MATTER

Unpredictable Supply: Only available when current owner decides to sell.

Unknown Shelf Life: Age and physical condition often uncertain.

Storage Risk: Long-term exposure to high humidity or heat significantly degrades performance and may damage equipment, especially the heads which can be extremely expensive to replace.

No Support: No warranty or technical assistance provided.

Variable Results: Quality can range from usable to completely degraded, depending on age and storage history.

Risk to Sound & Gear: Deterioration may not be visible and can lead to audio dropouts or harm equipment.

Inconsistent Formulas: Tapes may have been produced in different eras with different formulations, leading to unpredictable results.

Potential Damage: Poor storage can cause tape to shed or become abrasive, threatening recording heads and internal components.
